

# Insight® Phlebotomy / Storage Cart Cleaning & Disinfection Instructions

#### **WARNING!**

- Always comply with facility cleaning standards and guidelines.
- Always follow directions on cleaning product label and heed warnings.
- Before using any cleaner, do a spot test on a small, inconspicuous area of your product to ensure it will not cause damage to the finish.
- Solvents, acidic or abrasive cleaners can damage surfaces and are not recommended.
- Wipe spills away promptly and rinse several times with water.

- Steel wool and other abrasive cleaning pads will damage the surface.
- Do not mix different cleaning agents to clean or disinfect.
- Avoid rust remover, drain cleaners and toilet bowl cleaners. These contain harsh chemicals and will quickly cause permanent damage.
- Avoid hair, textile, and food dyes, as they can cause permanent stains.
- Disinfectants with high concentrations of isopropyl alcohol and / or bleach can be corrosive to plastic with prolonged use.

### PRODUCT FOR GENERAL CLEANING

Soap and water are recommended for general cleaning needs.

## PRODUCT FOR DISINFECTION

When disinfection is necessary the following products may be used:

### RECOMMENDED CLEANING PROCESS

- 1. Wipe up any spills and remove any debris before applying cleaner.
- 2. Apply cleaner/disinfectant according to directions on the cleaning agent label.
- 3. Avoid using sprays on products with electronic components (e.g., electronic locks).
- 4. Ensure that cleaning solution is wiped away promptly, adhering to the label instructions.
- 5. Dispose used cleaning cloths and solutions appropriately.
